“The Future of San Diego – WHERE Your Dollars Will be Spent”

15 February – SDCWA – John Economides, Director of Engineering
(Water Collection, Retention and Distribution)

What would happen to our water supply in the event of a major earthquake? What are we doing to collect and store more of what little rainfall we get in San Diego County? What is being done to interconnect the major reservoirs in San Diego County, so what water is available can be shared by all communities in need?

John Economides will answer these questions and more in discussing the various elements of the \$850 Million ESP (Emergency Storage Project), including North America’s largest roller compacted concrete dam (Olivenhain), a 10 mile 12foot diameter tunnel in construction from Rancho Penasquitos to San Vicente Dam, raising San Vicente Dam to double its capacity, and a host of supporting projects in design or construction.
