

“San Diego’s Future” Series concludes

The final sessions of the 5-part, 5-month “San Diego’s Future” Series covered the projects and progress being made at the Port of San Diego (April), and the San Diego Regional Airport (May).

Participation ranged from a low of 40 to a high of 55 registered for the Series, and the chapter will sign up a minimum of five new members from this group, including one of our speakers and his deputy.

In addition to elevating our local SAVE chapter in the community and among other professional societies, we have developed new contact lists with the media and within the agencies that did participate at the speaker level, and as attendees. Added “frosting on the cake” was a net profit of over \$1800, which we are using to offer \$50 “credits” to all new members joining before 30 June. We also will be subsidizing a number of events with that surplus, starting with a [wine and cheese tasting](#) on 21 June to “celebrate” the conclusion of our Series. Other “summer social” events are a Padres baseball game on 21 July (for which we have sold all the tickets we purchased); and, for August, it’ll be a DOG DAY at Miramar Lake picnic, for which we will provide hot dogs, side dishes, salads, and refreshments for \$10 per person, with kids under 13 free. Plans are in work for events every month through 2007 year end, when we’ll have a new member reception and holiday social at a nice restaurant locally.
